Journey Highlights

Tanzania is a captivating country with extraordinary game viewing and quintessential African landscapes. The parks in the north boast open savannah, acacia trees and huge herds of game including one of the world's great wildlife spectacles, the Great Wildebeest Migration. On this adventure you stay at the Sanctuary Serengeti Migration Camp, a traditional safari camp which moves seasonally between three locations ensuring guests are always in the best spot to experience this extraordinary phenomenon.



Itinerary

Day 1: Arrive Arusha.

A warm A&K welcome and private transfer to your lodge located on the country's largest coffee plantation.

Arusha Coffee Lodge (Plantation Suite)

Day 2: Arusha – Tarangire.

This morning you are driven (approx. 5hrs) to Tarangire National Park, home to one of the country's largest elephant populations. Your camp is situated in a remote corner of the park amongst giant acacia trees with views out beyond the savannah. The landscape is filled with ancient baobab trees, ambling elephants and birds in flight. Head out on a walking safari or a night game drive in search of elusive nocturnal animals rarely seen by visitors.

Sanctuary Swala (Canvas Pavilion) - Meals: B, L, D

Day 3: Tarangire National Park.

This park is famous for its large herds of elephants which migrate through the park in search of water between July and October. Breathtaking views of the Maasai Steppe and the mountains to the south make a stop at Tarangire a memorable experience. A full day allows time for plenty of game viewing and a visit to the AKP beekeeping project.

Sanctuary Swala (Canvas Pavilion) - Meals: B, L, D

Day 4: Tarangire National Park – Ngorongoro Crater.

Today travel to the Ngorongoro Conservation area, stopping for lunch at Gibb's Farm, a working coffee plantation in the highlands, with time to stretch your legs. Later this afternoon, arrive in camp, located on the crater rim with spectacular views.

Sanctuary Ngorongoro Crater Camp (Safari Tent) - Meals: B, L, D

Day 5: Ngorongoro Crater.

Descend into this vast extinct volcano whose towering walls are a natural enclosure for a dazzling abundance of wildlife. See wildebeest, zebra, buffalo and gazelle on the plains, waterbuck, bushbuck and eland in the forest, a healthy elephant population, black rhino, lion, hippo and flamingos. On return to camp stop at a traditional Maasai Village.

Sanctuary Ngorongoro Crater Camp (Safari Tent) - Meals: B, L, D

Day 6: Ngorongoro – Serengeti National Park.

This morning board your light aircraft flight into the world famous Serengeti. Game viewing in the park varies depending on the time of year. Your classic tented safari camp is mobile and moves seasonally between three sites according to the movement of the game, ensuring you are always in the best spot to witness the Great Wildebeest Migration.

Sanctuary Kichakani Serengeti Camp (Safari Tent) - Meals: B, L, D

Days 7–8: Serengeti National Park.

With an expert safari guide, explore the vast plains of the Serengeti in search of predators and other game for the next two days. The Serengeti plays host to a wonderful spectacle each year – the annual migration of millions of wildebeest and zebra who follow the rains in their continual search for grass and water – an unforgettable experience.

Sanctuary Kichakani Serengeti Camp (Safari Tent) - Meals: B, L, D

Day 9: Serengeti – Depart Arusha.

A flight returns you to Arusha or Kilimanjaro where your Tanzanian safari ends.

Sanctuary Kichakani Serengeti Camp

In December 2017, the exclusive new Sanctuary Kichakani Serengeti Camp in Tanzania will be revealed. An extraordinary new escape, the camp will be based across three locations in the Serengeti, allowing guests to intimately experience the Great Wildebeest Migration.

The camp has been designed to be packed up and moved along in a style reminiscent of the pioneering explorers of the 19th century, yet with all the modern comforts. An elegant contemporary take on the classic campaign look, Sanctuary Kichakani Serengeti Camp will offer accommodation under canvas in 10 new five-star tents, each with wooden deck, en suite bathrooms, authentic bucket showers plus a personal tent attendant. Gym and yoga kits are also standard in each tent. Thanks to the on-the-go nature of the whole sand-coloured canvas-constructed camp, there is little impact on the environment, minimising the ecological footprint.

The camp will also feature a grand central canopied area where the main tent flows into lounges and dining wings. The tents can be open on the sides to reveal the soul-stirring landscape and the chef and his team will serve up a melange of international and local flavours. Guests can enjoy the traditional fire pit, exchanging stories under starry skies and listening to tales of wildlife encounters and historical derring-do from passionate guides.

Sanctuary Ngorongoro Crater Camp



Located right on the rim of the Ngorongoro Crater, this camp boasts views of and access to one of Tanzania's most exciting wildlife arenas. There are 10 luxury safari tents here, each with en suite bathroom and indoor bucket shower. There is also a dining tent, lounge and bar tent. Bush picnic lunches are a highlight with camp meals always set against the incredible backdrop. Open 4WD game viewing on the crater floor is the main attraction as well as cultural village visits.

Activities include game drives in the crater and around the rim.

Sanctuary Swala Camp is located in an exclusive pocket of Tarangire, a national park noted for its elephant population and spectacular baobabs of every shape and colour. The camp itself is located under a canopy of *Acacia tortilis*, creating a beautiful setting. Accommodation is offered in 12 canvas pavilions with views over the waterhole and plains in front of camp. En suite bathrooms and hot running water are standard plus private balconies with comfortable furnishings in front of each tent. A stunning infinity pool overlooks the nearby waterhole often visited by elephants as well as predators.

Activities here include game drives, night drives, walking safaris and visits to the AKP sponsored beekeeping project.
