Fully escorted with an expert trip leader and local guide

Each expedition has a leadership team of two: an expert on the trip theme to narrate the story of the journey (an academic, author or researcher) plus a local



guide who shares their local knowledge, culture and experience to reveal the spirit of their country. They are the ultimate travel companions, and are trained to make every part of the trip safe and seamless.

Maximum group size of 12-16 travellers

Small groups of like-minded travellers allow low-impact, intimate access to our destinations and more time with our experts. Each member of our group will be an integral part of the expedition, with our small group size allowing us to learn more about our traveller's interests and incorporating them into the experience.

Exclusive Access
